Re: Scheduled Date for the ServSafe Food Safety Manager Certification Course

Clermont County Public Health is again offering the ServSafe Food Safety Manager Certification Course, an approved course of study in food protection, starting on Tuesday, July 19, 2022. This course, developed by the National Restaurant Association (NRA) and approved by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) as an official certification course, is a 16-hour course with a 90-question exam administered immediately following the course work. After successfully completing the course and passing the exam with 75% or greater, the participant will become certified in food protection by the NRA and the ODH. This certification demonstrates advanced knowledge in safe food preparation practices, and fulfills the new requirement(s) as outlined in Chapter 3717-1-02.4(A)(2) of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Serving food to many customers on a daily basis is a daunting task, and the potential for errors in purchasing, receiving, storing, preparing, holding, and serving exists at all facilities. Food handlers should not only base their concern for food safety on a foundation of goodwill and good intentions but also on a sound understanding of sanitary policies and procedures.

A food safety certification course is a good opportunity for you and your staff to learn more about protecting those you serve from food-borne illness. Attendees will learn up-to-date information on how to prevent food borne illness, along with many other current food safety topics.

The course is presented in English in two 8 hour sessions from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm on July 19 and 20, 2022. Both sessions must be attended, and a passing score of 75% achieved on the exam to be eligible for certification. The course will be held at Clermont County Public Health, 2275 Bauer Road, Suite 300, Batavia, OH 45103. The cost of the course is \$150.00, and covers the textbook, course work, handouts, exam, NRA and ODH certifications. Class will break 45 minutes for lunch each day and lunch is on your own. The deadline for registration is July 15, 2022, by which time the \$150.00 course registration is due. Textbooks and exams are available in a variety of different languages, so if you require these materials in your native language, please specify your language preference on the registration form below. Space is limited to 24 participants.
