What community resource gives you access to adventure, entertainment, knowledge, and technology for free? The Library! A card from Clermont County Public Library allows you to check out movies, books, downloadable audios, music, databases, and more. In fact, your card gives you access to items from across the county and state at no cost to you. Have you been wanting to read or see *Where the Crawdads Sing*? Do you like listening to audiobooks or music during your day? Would you like to research Consumer Reports for your next purchase but don't have a subscription? Would you like to learn more about nutrition and physical activity? The Clermont County Public Library can provide all of these for you for free.

Only Here can you find four different kinds of library cards to fit your needs. Besides the standard card with access to all physical and online materials, the Library also offers an eCard which gives access to online materials only, an educator card for teachers and homeschool parents, and a 3 For Me card for students which carries no overdue fines and has limited checkout. In September, libraries nationwide celebrate National Library Card Sign-Up Month because not only is a card a great school supply to have for homework help, but it also provides a great variety of resources to all in the community. Did you know the Library provides educational kits to help engage your kids in learning; has downloadable digital content for your phone, TV, or tablet; subscribes to the Ancestry database so you can research your family tree on a library computer; provides wi-fi hotspots for checkout; and has the latest bestsellers and movies? All you need is a library card. Anyone over the age of three who lives or teaches in the state of Ohio can get one of our cards for free.

If you stop by your local branch in September, you can also pick up a free library tote bag. It is perfect to carry all the fun items you checkout. Stop by with your current photo ID and library staff will create a card for you, or update your existing card. Then you'll be all set to use our computers or laptops, checkout physical items, download digital materials that return themselves when the time runs out, explore one of our databases, find your next book club selection, or bring home a STEAM kit for your kids.
