

RESOLUTION NO. 16 -22

The Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District met in regular session on the 14th day of December, 2022 with the following members present:

Mr. Brown moved for adoption of the following resolution:

Resolution Revising the License Fees for Risk Levels I and II Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District has the authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09 to establish a uniform system of fee services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent or restrict disease, and abate or suppress nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District has determined that it is necessary to revise the license fees for risk levels I and II food service operations or retail food establishments; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District determined that the license fees for risk levels I and II food service operations or retail food establishments adopted on November 9, 2022 was in excess of that allowed pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that license fees for the following services be revised as stated:

Program	2023 Health District Fee	State Fee	Total Fee
Commercial Risk Level 1 less than 25, 000 sq. ft.	\$133.00	\$28.00	\$161.00
Commercial Risk Level 2 less than 25, 000 sq. ft.	\$151.00	\$28.00	\$179.00
Non-Commercial Risk Level 1 less than 25, 000 sq. ft.	\$66.50	\$14.00	\$80.50
Non-Commercial Risk Level 2 less than 25, 000 sq. ft.	\$75.50	\$14.00	\$89.50

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all fees revised pursuant to this Resolution hereby become effective on January 1, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District hereby find by a vote of at least three fourths (3/4) of its members that this resolution be read only once, and the requirement that it be read on three different days be dispensed with as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that the revised fees be recorded and certified to become part of the record of local regulation by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by this Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that this regulation be published in one newspaper of general circulation that is in the Clermont County General Health District once a week for two consecutive weeks and that the first publication take place no later than 10 days prior to the effective date of the revision adopted herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance of the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
